

Rules and Protocol for City of Milford/Milford-Miami Twp. Community Signs

Large Signs Containing Service Organization Signs (S.R. 28 and Milford Parkway)

- Individual signs permitted for non-profit service organizations, at the discretion of the City/Chamber Sign Committee
- Permanent service organization signs shall not have a dimension larger than 30 inches
- Organizations must supply their signs at not cost to the City or Chamber
- Layout/location of individual signs at discretion of City/Chamber Sign Committee
- City will install individual signs
- Banners advertising City-wide events organized by non-profit organizations shall be permitted to be hung, by the City, on the base of the sign with permission by the City/Chamber Sign Committee
- Said banners will be permitted for four weeks prior to an event and will be removed within three days after the event
- Due to area constraints between sign posts, banners cannot exceed 3 feet by 6 feet

Pedestrian Scale Sign (Little Miami Bike Path)

- Message board will contain new shopping map and directory developed by the Milford Task Force
- One key for the locking message board will be in possession of the City and one in possession of the Chamber
- Temporary messages, fliers, maps, etc. benefiting the community as a whole for placement on message board will be permitted at the approval of the City/Chamber Sign Committee. Such temporary items for the locking message board will not be permitted to monopolize all available space.
- Small, temporary banner on the base of the sign permitted as above, with size limit of 1.5 feet by 3 feet
- Include two small dispensers with lids to contain trail map being developed by Parks and Rec Commission and the shopping map and directory produced by the Milford Task Force
