Official Rules

Scarecrows can be traditional, funny, scary or original. They are for family viewing, so the City's Scarecrow Committee reserves the right not to display any scarecrow at their discretion. Please remember this a fun, family event that we hope to make an annual fall tradition!

A free scarecrow frame will be available at the City administration building (745 Center Street) beginning on 9/15. Please use the to create your scarecrow around so they can be secured to the pole and include a waterproof 8 1/2 x 11" sign with your name or organization to be displayed.

Trophies, City of Milford Swag and "bragging rights" will be awarded in three categories.

- Top Family/Individual Scarecrow
- Top Organization/Group/Business Scarecrow
- Mayor's Choice Scarecrow

Scarecrows must be made to withstand weather conditions for 30 days, some tips include:

- no perishable goods(squash, pumpkins etc)
- Stuffing can be anything but newspaper and water soluble peanuts will not work, plastic bags work best.
- Hair can be made from a variety of materials including yarn, pipe cleaners, beads, moss, rope, raffia, torn fabric or mop heads....be creative!
- Suggestions for the scarecrow's head include milk jugs, flower pots, dried gourds, wood,

basketballs,

plastic pumpkins or mop heads are great choices.
